

## RKVY

Rashtrya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) project was started in Mizoram during 2010-2011 as an umbrella scheme for ensuring holistic development of agriculture and allied sectors by allowing states to choose their own agriculture and allied sector development activities as per the district/state agriculture plan. Under the nodality of Agriculture Department in Mizoram, the department of Land Resources, Soil & Water Conservation has been one of the implementing departments since the inception of the project.

The area focused under RKVY by Land Resources, Soil & Water Conservation Department, Mizoram are production and productivity enhancement of Agriculture lands where the main crops are paddy, vegetables and cash crops. **Production enhancement measures adopted will be water harvesting structures and distribution of harvested water through pipes to individual fields; terracing including logwood bunding and moisture conservation trenches; protection works of WRC areas (drainage line treatment) to prevent soil/bank erosion of WRC areas; series of checkdams to retain moisture and debris for better ground water recharging and afforestation/agro-forestry.** This RKVY project focused on mainly sustainability and equity.

### AIMS & OBJECTIVES:-

1. Control & prevention of soil erosion in the upper, middle and lower reaches.
2. Conservation of rain water to enhance production and productivity of agriculture land in the middle and lower reaches.
3. Improvement of current jhum lands.
4. To minimize water scarcity during lean season.
5. Enhancement of socio-economic status of stake holders.

Based on feedback received from States, experiences garnered during implementation in the 12th Plan and inputs provided by stakeholders, RKVY guidelines have been revamped as **RKVY – RAFTAAR - Remunerative Approaches for Agriculture and Allied sector Rejuvenation to enhance efficiency, efficacy and inclusiveness of the programme.**

Till 2013-14, the scheme was implemented as an Additional Central Assistance (ACA) to State Plan Scheme with 100% central assistance. It was

converted into a Centrally Sponsored Scheme in 2014-15 also with 100% central assistance. From 2015-16, the funding pattern of the scheme has been altered in the ratio of 60:40 between Centre and States (**90:10 for North Eastern States and Himalayan States**). For Union Territories the funding pattern is 100 % central grant.

Since 2021-2022, **Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT)** mode of payment has been initiated using Public Financial Management System (PFMS) integrated Single Nodal Account (SNA) for RKVY.

### **Programme Components (Streams):**

RKVY-RAFTAAR funds would be provided to the States as grant by the Central Government in the following streams.

#### **A. Regular RKVY-RAFTAAR -70% of annual outlay will be allocated among States as per criteria under following heads.**

1. Infrastructure and assets-**50% (of 70%) of regular RKVY-RAFTAAR outlay**-pre-harvest infrastructure-20%, post-harvest infrastructure- 30%
2. Value addition linked production projects (agribusiness models) that provide assured/ additional income to farmers including Public Private Partnership for Integrated Agriculture Development (PPPIAD) projects - **30% (of 70%) of regular RKVY outlay.**
3. Flexi funds- **20% (of 70%) of regular RKVY-RAFTAAR outlay.** States can use this fund for supporting any projects as per their local needs preferably for innovative activities in agriculture and allied sectors.

**B. RKVY-RAFTAAR special sub-schemes – 20% of total annual outlay -** based on national priorities as notified by Govt. of India from time to time for development of region and problem specific areas.

**C. Innovation and agri-entrepreneur development - 10% of annual outlay** - for encouraging innovation and agri-entrepreneurs through skill development and financial support. It will support incubatees, incubation centers, KVKs, awards etc. These funds will be with Central Govt. (DAC&FW) including 2% of administrative costs at the Centre. **In case the funds are not utilized, they will be diverted to regular RKVY and sub-schemes.**
